- ◆ Contests are open to all New Jersey students in grades Pre-K–12 from public or private schools as well as those who are homeschooled.
- ◆Winners will be selected in each of the following grade-level groups:

Pre-K-2

3-5

6–9

9 - 12

- ◆Only one entry per student per contest is permitted (one for Art & one for Writing.)
- ◆ Teachers, please submit only the best two student art creations and the best two student writing creations from each class.
- ◆ Entries must be submitted electronically **no later than Friday, December 16, 2022.**
- ◆Winners will be notified by January 27, 2023.
- ◆Work must specify it was created between September 16, 2022, and December 16, 2022.

ART REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Artwork must relate to the theme of *collaboration*.
- 2. Must be two-dimensional in any medium—<u>NO</u> three-dimensional elements allowed.
- 3. Entry limited to one high-res image only.
- 4. Please submit a submission form and a picture of the artwork at https://njagc.org/njagc-contests-and-awards/

WRITING REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Entries must relate to the theme of *collaboration*.
- 2. Must be no longer than two pages, double-spaced, typed and can be in the form of a creative piece, poem, essay, etc.
- 4. Use 12-point Times New Roman font.
