

2023 Music Composition Contest

Submission Guidelines

1. **PARTICIPANTS** The New Jersey Association for Gifted Children (NJAGC) invites students of New Jersey public, private, or home schools, in grades K-12, to submit original, instrumental music compositions.

- 2. **JUDGING** All pieces will be judged on:
 - Originality
 - Melodic development
 - Compositional proficiency
 - Demonstration of understanding of the instrument's capabilities
 - All pieces must modulate to explore a new key

NOTE: If only a single entry is received, NJAGC reserves the right to defer the award for that division.

3. GUIDELINES

Sheet Music (to be submitted)	Optional	Optional	Recommended	Required

- Compositions must be instrumental, without lyrics.
- Compositions must be entirely student-created with adults acting as consultants only. Adults may NOT do any of the actual composition work. Arrangements of pieces by other composers will not be accepted.
- Compositions may be played by the student or another person. If the piece is
 played by someone other than the student composer, sheet music must be
 submitted, regardless of Grade Division.
- Submissions must include a signed statement by a parent verifying that they are entirely student-created, whether done at home or in school (see form below).
- 4. **SUBMISSION FORMAT** Compositions can be submitted as video file (WebM, .MPEG4, .3GPP, .MOV, .AVI, .MPEGPS, .WMV, .FLV, .ogg) or audio file (MP3, MPEG, WAV, .ogg, .opus). A performance can also be submitted via YouTube link. All entries must be accompanied by a scanned, signed parental permission form (see below). - 5. **ENTRY DIVISIONS** There are four grade divisions.
